

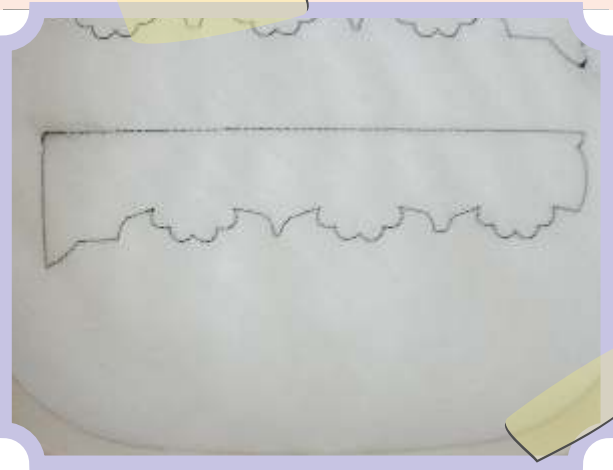
BESV380 LACE CHOKER

What you will need

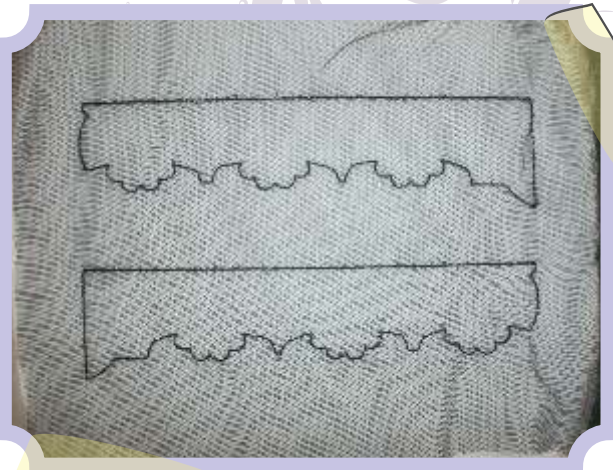


- FINE MESH, BRIDAL MESH OR STRETCH MESH.
 - EMBROIDERY THREADS
 - WATER SOLUBLE STABILIZER
 - 10mm WIDE RIBBON
 - DECORATIVE CAMEO WITH SURROUND.
- **DECORATIVE ITEMS OF YOUR CHOICE:**
 - CHAIN
 - JUMPERS
 - PEARLS
 - CRYSTALS
 - RHINESTONES

Let's Begin



- Hoop up 2 layers of water soluble stabilizer,
- Stitch out the die line.



- Remove the hoop from the machine.
- Stick down a piece of mesh over the die line.
- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch out the tack down stitch.



- Remove the hoop from the machine and trim away all excess mesh.



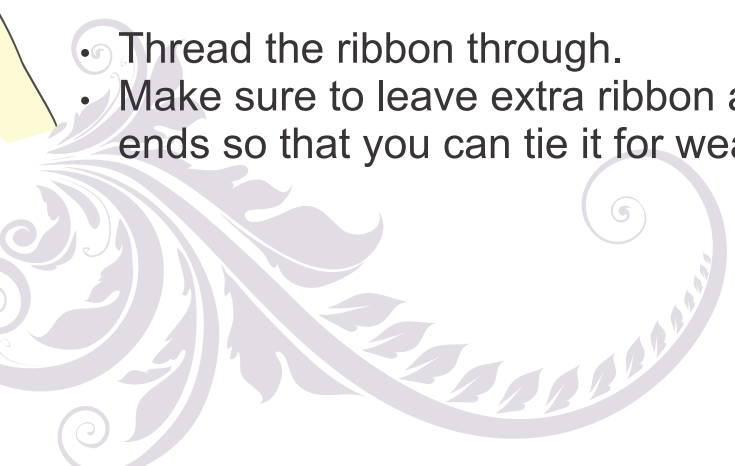
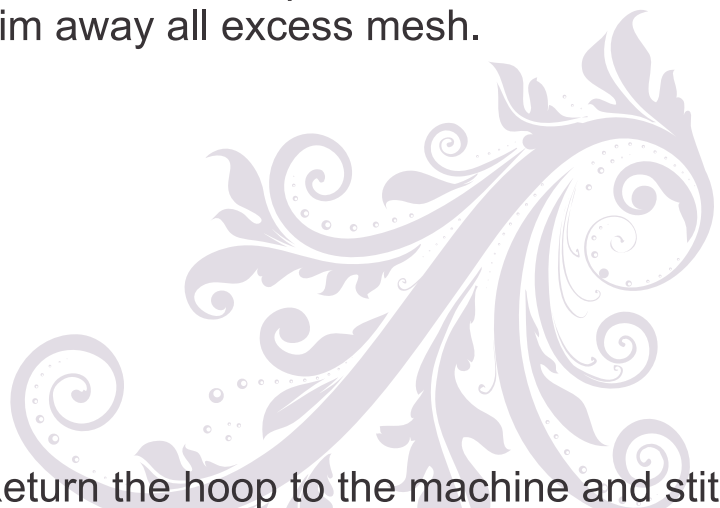
- Return the hoop to the machine and stitch out the remainder of the design.
- Once complete, remove the design from the hoop.
- Trim away excess stabilizer.
- Rinse the stitch out in hot soapy water and rinse out under some clean water and leave to dry.



- Stitch the two halves together to get the full length.
- You can hand sew them together or use a zig-zag stitch on your sewing machine.
- Cut out the area inside the little ovals, this is where the ribbon will thread through.



- Thread the ribbon through.
- Make sure to leave extra ribbon at both ends so that you can tie it for wearing.





- Using craft glue stick the cameo or decorative piece on to the lace.



- Using chain, jumpers and pearls, rhinestones or crystals decorate your choker till your heart is content.
