Continuous Ribbon with Free Standing Lace

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Hi Friends

Today we are going to make a trim using 1" width Ribbon and our own Free Standing Lace. You can make this trim any length you need. Use the continuous method to make your trim the length you need. You can edge both edges of ribbon with lace or just the one side. I'm going to show you how!



What you will need

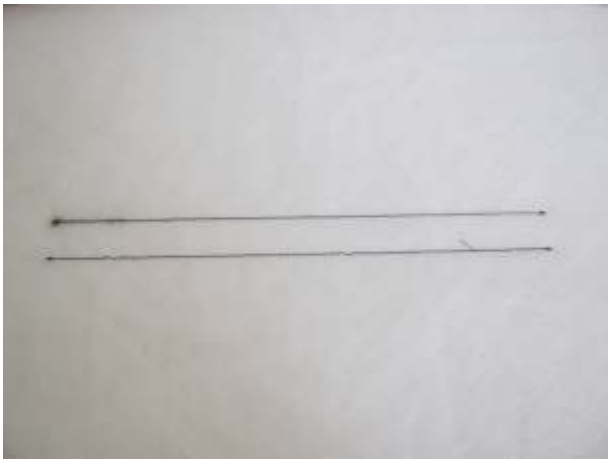
Hoop: 5"x7"

Water-Soluble Stabilizer - wss

Fabric Temporary Spray Adhesive

1" width Ribbon - any length required





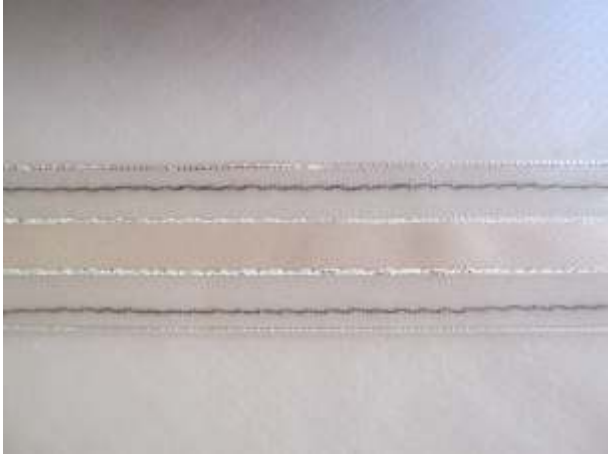
Ribbon with FSL on both edges

1. Firstly, cut your ribbon the required length plus an extra 2 inches for neatening either end.

Use your 5x7" Hoop and hoop up with wss. Stitch the 2 placement lines for the ribbon on the stabilizer.



2. Spray the stabilizer between the 2 placement lines with Fabric Temporary Adhesive Spray.



3. Gently press the ribbon in place. The ribbon must overlap both placement lines.



4. Stitch the ribbon in place.



5. Stitch the lace.

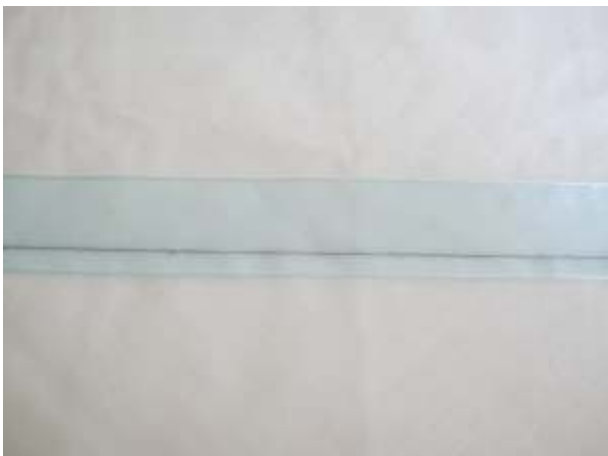


6. To do continuous hooping to make the trim longer, re-hoop and use placement.

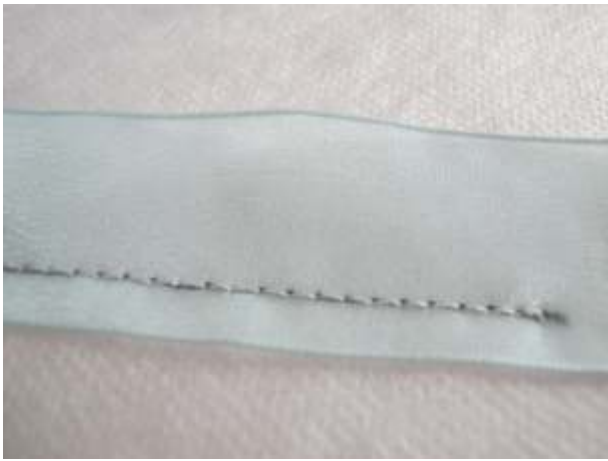


Ribbon with FSL on one side.

1. Hoop up with wss. Stitch out 1 placement line for the ribbon.



2. Spray the stabilizer with Fabric Temporary Spray Adhesive. Gently press the ribbon in place. The ribbon must overlap the placement line.



3. Stitch the ribbon in place.



3. Now stitch the lace. To make the trim longer, re-hoop and use placement.



For all trims, when done, cut away embroidery from the stabilizer, rinse, dry and use as needed.
