



CE473, 474 and 475 Versailles **Quilt Blocks**

Hoops: Quilt Blocks fit 6 x 6 inches/150 x 150 mm and 8 x 8 inches/200 x 200 mm

These Quilt Blocks come in 2 sizes and make lovely Quilts. The 3 Design Sets are all made in the same way. I used a lovely Poly-cotton for the entire square with a contrast fabric for the centre square. I put a very thin Batting (optional) under the centre square fabric to give a slight puffy effect. To prevent your fabric from fraying, spray with No Fray. Tip: Cut the Batting a little smaller than the centre square outline, it prevents an untidy edge.

METHOD

1. Hoop 1 layer of Cut-Away Stabilizer.

Materials:

Poly-Cotton Fabric plain or print of your choice.

Optional: Thin layer of Batting to go under Centre square fabric

Cut-away Stabilizer

Thread

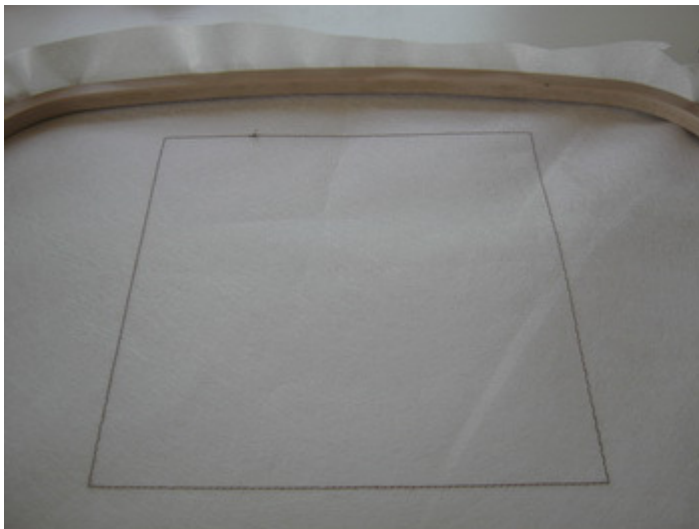
No-Fray Spray for fabrics that fray

Sharp-pointed

embroidery
scissors and pins



2. Stitch the outline of the square onto the stabilizer.



3. Place the fabric over the area and stitch in place as well as the decorative border.



4. Stitch the outline of the centre. Cut a piece of thin batting a little smaller than the square





5. Now cut a piece of fabric a little larger than the square. If your fabric tends to fray, spray with No-Fray. Pin in place away from the stitching area.



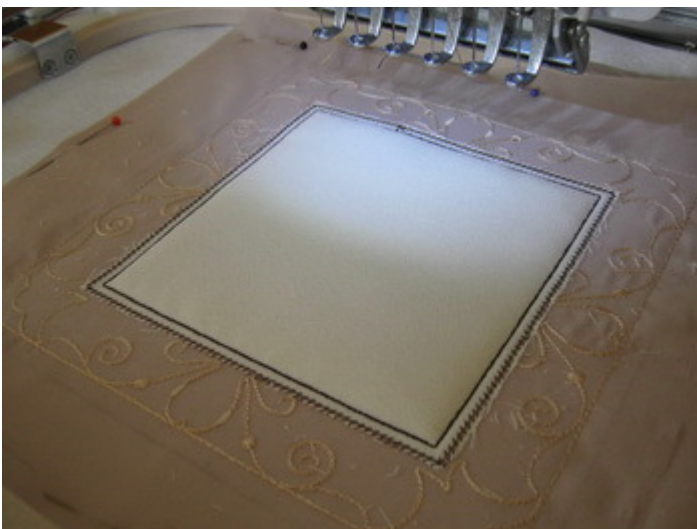
6. Stitch in place..



7. Trim



8. Stitch the decorative edges round the square.



9. Now stitch the centre Motif.
